What's the HAP?

Home Access Program



Through the HAP, SILCGA is working to fund home retrofitting so that low-income individuals with disabilities can safely navigate their homes.



In spite of a recent increase in funding for home modifications, the statewide waiting list has increased to over 600 people with disabilities who face daily challenges of accessing & navigating their homes safely.



State funding of \$500K to the Department of Community Affairs will allow the Centers to assist approx. 60 constituents per year with their home modification needs such as ramps & bathroom modifications.



With additional funding, individuals will be able to safely navigate or return to their own homes after disabling events. Georgia will save a considerable expense when nursing facility placement is avoided.
