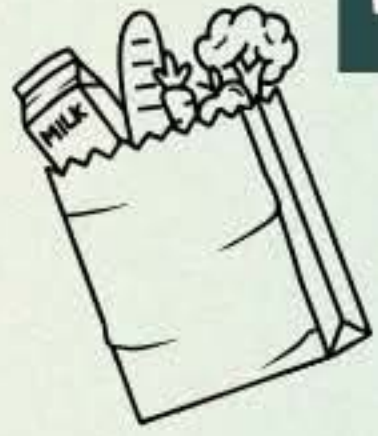

Due to the government shutdown, people across our region will not receive their payment from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, otherwise known as **SNAP**, for the month of November. Losing **SNAP** will make it more difficult for many people to buy food for themselves and their families. New Disabled South is offering one-time payments to help people impacted by not receiving **SNAP**. Funding is first-come, first-served. This means that we will give one-time payments to people until we run out of funds. We will give \$100 to individuals and \$250 to households with two or more people.
